NECP Information Technology Acceptable Use Agreement ~ 2017-2018

North East Carolina Prep School uses various forms of technology to enhance the educational experience for students, faculty, and staff. Access to technology, including the Internet, is a fundamental right and expectation of lifelong learners and global citizens. Use of computers is a privilege, not a right. Although certain risks are inherent when using technology, it is the opinion of the educational community that the wealth of information and interaction available via electronic resources far outweigh the potential for damage or access to objectionable material. The North East Carolina Prep School electronic network will be guarded with firewall and content filtering capabilities. However, it is impossible to protect the network against every potential threat. Unforeseen events may include, but are not limited to, students accessing material that may be found offensive and inconsistent with educational goals, unauthorized users gaining access to materials and information, and loss of corruption of data stored on the network servers.

All users, including parents of students under age 18, of the North East Carolina Prep School network are expected to read, and acknowledge the acceptance or denial of the North East Carolina Prep School Acceptable Use Policy for Electronic Access. Denial of, or conditional agreement to, the Acceptable Use Policy will result in restricted use of the electronic network. A signed agreement, a username and password will be assigned to all network users prior to accessing the North East Carolina Prep School electronic network.

Network/Internet User Agreement and Parent Information

We are pleased to offer students of North East Carolina Prep School access to the computer network resources, electronic mail and the Internet. To use these resources, all students and parents must agree to the policy stated below. Any questions or concerns about these policies or any aspect of the computer network should be referred to the Executive Director or his designee.

General Network Use

The network is provided for students to conduct research, complete assignments, and communicate with others.

Access to network services is given to students, who agree to act in a considerate and responsible manner. Students are responsible for good behavior on school computer networks just as they are in a classroom or a school hallway.

Access is a privilege – not a right. As such, general school rules for behavior and communications apply. All users must comply with school standards and honor the agreements they have signed. Beyond the clarification of such standards, the school is not responsible for restricting, monitoring or controlling the communications of individuals utilizing the network.

Network storage areas may be treated like school lockers. Network administrator may review files and communications to maintain system integrity and insure that users are using the system responsibly. Users should not expect that files stored on school servers will always be private.

Internet - World Wide Web - E-mail Access

Access to the Internet and e-mail will enable students to use thousands of libraries and databases. Within reason, freedom of speech and access to information will be honored. Families should be warned that some material accessible via the Internet might contain items that are illegal, defamatory, inaccurate or potentially offensive to some people. While our intent is to make Internet access available to gather educational goals and objectives, students may find ways to access other materials as well. Filtering software is in use, but no filtering system is capable of blocking 100% of the inappropriate material available on the Internet. We believe that the benefits to students from access to the Internet, in the form of information resources and opportunities for collaboration, exceed any disadvantages. Ultimately, parent and guardians of minors are responsible for setting and conveying the standards that their children should follow when using media and information sources. To that end, North East Carolina Prep School will support and respect each family's right to decide whether or not to apply for access.

Publishing to the World Wide Web

Student work may be considered for publication on the teacher’s website. Such publishing requires parent or guardian permission. The work will appear with a copyright notice prohibiting the copying of such work without express written permission. In the event anyone requests such permission, those requests will be forwarded to the student’s parent or guardian.

Unidentified photos of students may be published on school websites, illustrating student projects and achievements. If you do not want your child’s photo to be published on the website, this should be indicated on the Acceptable Use Policy form distributed to all NECP families at the beginning of the school year.

The North East Carolina Prep School Acceptable Use Policy is designed to protect the rights and privileges of all electronic network users. NECP supports and respects each family’s right to decline network privileges for any student.

The following activities are prohibited on school computers:

- Transmission of any material in violation of any U.S. or state regulations, including, but not limited to: copyrighted material, threatening, harassing, or obscene language or material, pornographic material, or material protected by trade secret. Any traffic from this network that traverses another network is also subject to that network’s acceptable use policy.
- Playing or downloading music or games, unless the activity is authorized by a teacher or administrator as part of a school program. Playing games within the computer lab, or any school computer, is only allowed if an adult has given students permission (outside of classroom instruction) and is present to supervise.
- Using the school’s Internet access for personal emailing and/or for business purposes

Any violation of the school’s Internet policy may result in a suspension or cancellation of network privileges. Administrators, teachers and system administrators will deem what is inappropriate and their decision is final.

Off-campus and Personal Technology Use

NECP reserves the right, to the maximum extent permitted by law, to discipline or take any other action against persons related to their personal electronic technology use (e.g., communications generated via private computers and/or Internet accounts, including social media platforms) when such use poses a substantial threat to others’ on-campus safety or to the operations of the school. This includes uses that cause or are likely to cause a substantial disruption or material interference with the school’s educational objectives or operations, or that otherwise injure or threaten to injure persons or property within the school community when they are participating in school-related matters.

NECP Directory Information/Image Release Form

North East Carolina Prep School is committed to protecting the privacy of all students and staff to the full extent of common sense and in compliance with the applicable state and federal laws. Parents/guardians should review the information below to insure their understanding of how images (pictures) and/or information about their children may be released.

Parents may choose to restrict the release of directory information and images; however, they must understand this is a not a selective restriction. Signing to restrict the release of information and images is all-inclusive and means: no pictures or listings in the yearbook, printed programs, or other school publications; no participation in school-related newspaper, television, or other media interviews or stories; no public announcements of awards, honors, or athletic achievements; etc.

DIRECTORY INFORMATION: Basic background information about students is considered public record and shall be released upon request. Directory information shall include: the student's name; the parents' or guardians' names; the student's age; the student's photograph; the student's participation in officially recognized activities and sports; the weight and height of members of athletic teams; the dates of student's attendance; degrees and awards received by the student; and the most recent previous educational agency or institution attended by the student. In addition, beginning in the 2017-18 school year, the addresses and telephone numbers of high school juniors and seniors may be released upon request to military recruiters or colleges, universities, scholarship committees, or other educational organizations for use in contacting potential recruits, applicants, or honorees.

Annually, parents, guardians and emancipated students are given an opportunity to object to release of directory information. Objections must be made in writing and placed with the student's record. If an objection is made, no directory information about that student will be released.

IMAGE USE: An NECP student's image/photograph and/or work may become part of a classroom or school project that could be used by NECP. These are examples of ways the images may be used:

- Used as a demonstration project/activity in education workshops/classes/conferences
- Used as sample project/activity on CDs created by NECP for use in education workshops and classrooms
- Posted on the NECP website, Facebook page, teachers' web pages, or school-affiliated web pages
- Submitted as samples to program publishers or as contest entries to sponsors
- Included in video presenting an academic project or computer multimedia in general
- Videotaped and/or interviewed to appear in a school-related program or news media broadcast
- Used in a printed publication such as a newspaper, magazine or yearbook
