Athletics

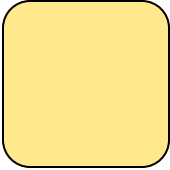

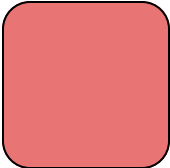

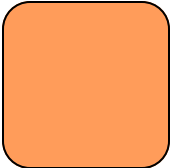
